☆Those who are already in Murodo-daira for sightseeing or mountain climbing can also participate. ※ No fare discount.

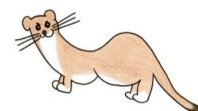
(Please inquire at the receptionist on the day of the event. Please note that this is intended for individuals and group applications are not accepted.)
